The Direct Debit Guarantee

- If the amounts to be paid or the payment dates change Social Care and Social Work Improvement Scotland will notify you 10 working days in advance of your account being debited or as otherwise agreed.
- If an error is made by the Social Care and Social Work Improvement Scotland or your Bank or Building Society, you are guaranteed a full and immediate refund from your branch of the amount paid.
- If you receive a refund you are not entitled to, you must pay it back when Social Care and Social Work Improvement Scotland ask you to.
- You can cancel a Direct Debit at any time by writing to your Bank or Building Society. Please also send a copy of your letter to us.
